Subject: COVID-19 Special Bus Service

Kindly take note of the following;

A special bus service will operate during 17 June until 14 July, according to the schedule below.

Important Rules to adhere to;

A student will not be allowed to enter a bus without a facemask and must have a valid UJ permit issued to them.

All passenger while traveling on the buses must wear the facemask and will not be allowed to remove it. Students must sanitize their hands before entering the bus.

Only two buses will operate doing a round trips, bus 1 starting at DFC via APB via APK and return to DFC, Bus 2 starting at SWC via APK via APB and return to SWC.
